

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

• Nail Anatomy

Nail artists have lots of mini canvases to work with on each nail, and these will be the medium in which you will be able to express your creativity and apply your skills as a nail artist. During this module we will dive into the basics of nail anatomy and learn to recognize when it is safe to perform a service, we will explore the most common nail diseases and disorders and review proper hand/nail examination. Each of these details will allow you to appropriately perform client consultations prior to moving ahead with a service.

• Salon Safety + Sanitation/ Disinfection procedures:

The best way to increase and maintain an efficient and healthy environment is to follow adequate cleaning and safety guidelines. During this module you will discover the differences between the different levels of infection control, proper cleaning and maintenance procedures and we will discuss and learn more about the current local guidelines for personal services. We will also discuss the general health and safety considerations that are of concern to you and your clients when working in a salon environment.

• Choosing the right brand / Product review and selection

There's an immense variety for nail artists when it comes to the product options available in the market, but how to choose the right line? How do products interact with each other? What is each product for? What brand is the right for me? During this module we will analyze some of the existing brands and suppliers and we will explore the options that they present to us, you will be able to have a clear understanding of what is needed in regards to tools, implements, products and supplies to perform a service and you will be able to understand the fundamentals of artificial nails.

• Manicure fundamentals

A manicure is the cosmetic care of the hands and fingernails, by now you have studied all the basis of what is needed to perform the service but how do you go about it? Well, in this module you will learn the basics of a manicure service, including preparation, consultation, service steps and completion and you'll have the opportunity to get to practice. You will also learn about gel polish and polish product selection and application as well as troubleshooting tips.

• Sculpted Gel Nails & Fills

In this section you'll be guided to developing strong application techniques, we will demonstrate and practice the procedures for application and maintenance of artificial nail extensions. You will be able to recognize the client's needs and address them with the right selection of the products needed as well as performing the service successfully. Our goal will be to you will also receive valuable troubleshooting tips.

• Electronic filing techniques

This module is an introduction to working with electronic files, upon further practice you will benefit from reducing filing times and improving time/cost per service. This part of the program is designed for you to understand and learn the correct and safe techniques for electric filing machines. Keep in mind that practicing the use of your e-file is crucial for successful and safe service performance.
